

Privax Wallet Privacy Policy

Effective Date: September 01, 2025

Privax Wallet ("we", "our", "us") is not a legal entity. This Privacy Policy applies solely to this software application and what is disclosed through the Chrome Dev Dashboard.

We only collect the data strictly necessary to enable the core functionality of the wallet. **We do not collect or store any personal data beyond what is required for the app to run.**

1. Information We Collect

We collect **only** the following data, and only because it is essential for the functionality of Privax Wallet:

- **Financial and Payment Information:** This includes blockchain-related transaction data necessary for the wallet to broadcast, track, and confirm transactions. We do **not** collect or transmit credit card numbers, credit ratings, financial statements, payment histories, or any other off-chain financial data.
- **Authentication Information:** This includes securely handled passphrases, PINs, or private keys generated and stored locally on your device strictly for wallet usage. We do **not** transmit or store credentials, passwords, security questions, or authentication data on our servers.

We do not collect any data unrelated to these functions—no personal details, no metadata beyond what's absolutely necessary, and no analytics for marketing or profiling.

2. Why We Collect This Information

- To process and relay blockchain transactions.
- To authorize and secure user access to their wallet.
- To maintain user security and functional integrity of the wallet extension.

We do **not** use your information for advertising, analytics, marketing, user tracking, or any unrelated purposes.

3. Data Storage and Control

- All required data is generated and **stored locally** on your device.
- We do **not** transmit, store, or back up this data externally.
- You retain full control over your keys, authentication details, and transaction data.

4. Data Sharing

We do not share, sell, rent, or exchange your data with any third party.

Your data is only used within the wallet extension and not disclosed externally unless required by law (e.g., responding to valid legal requests).

5. Your Rights

- You have complete control and ownership of your local data—including private keys, passphrases, and transaction history.
- You may delete all locally stored information at any time by uninstalling the extension or using reset features.
- No data is held by us; therefore, we cannot access, correct, or delete wallet data for you.

6. Updates to This Policy
